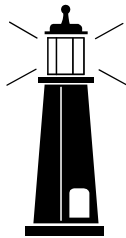

LOCK IT OR LOOSE IT

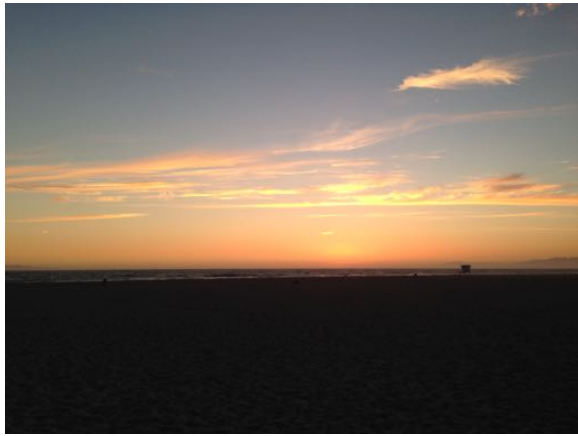
As usual this time of year, there has been an increase in theft from motor vehicles. Please keep your car locked and valuables out of sight.

The sunset pictures in the Beacon have been taken over the last 15 years at Hollywood Beach. Each one reflects a sunset during the month the Beacon is published. This one is from August, 2015. You can tell the time of year by where the Sun sets with respect to the Santa Cruz Island. The same tilt of the Earth that gives us our seasons causes the Sun to set over Santa Cruz Island during the winter months and closer to Point Conception during the summer months.

* Leaking gas

* Smoke or fire

* Anything that would put someone in danger

Locking yourself out of your unit is not an emergency. If the office is open, they might be able to help you if you have provided a key.
