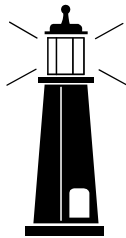

## HARBORWALK ANNUAL HOMEOWNER’S MEETING

As the City, County, and State begin to relax stay-at-home orders, HarborWalk is planning how we can reopen all of our facilities in a safe manor. The HarborWalk Board of Directors are working on reopening the pool areas in compliance with Health Department guidelines. Expect fewer numbers of residents allowed in the pool areas, pools, and spas. It may require time limits on facility usage with sign-up sheets to regulate the flow of residents.

The tennis courts have remained open and will continue to be available for residents to play while practicing social distancing.

Until further notice, the Harborwalk office will continue to operate on a slightly shorter schedule.

The HarborWalk maintenance staff continues to work as does the landscape contractor.

## HOLLYWOOD BEACH COMMUNITY

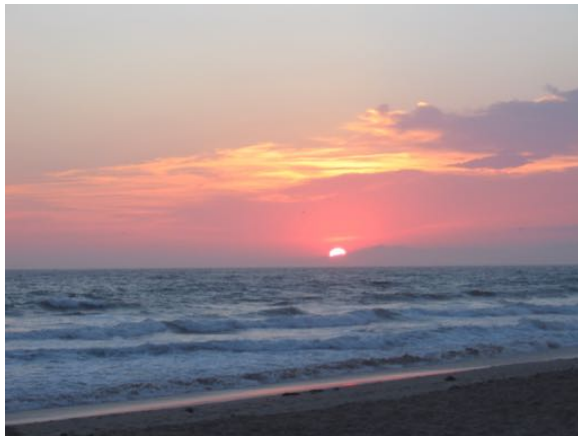

The sunset pictures in the Beacon have been taken over the last 15 years at Hollywood Beach. Each one reflects a sunset during the month the Beacon is published. This one is from June, 2006. You can tell the time of year by where the Sun sets with respect to the Santa Cruz Island. The same tilt of the Earth that gives us our seasons causes the Sun to set over Santa Cruz Island during the winter months and closer to Point Conception during the summer months.
