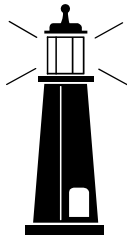

## CHANNEL ISLANDS HARBOR MARINAFEST

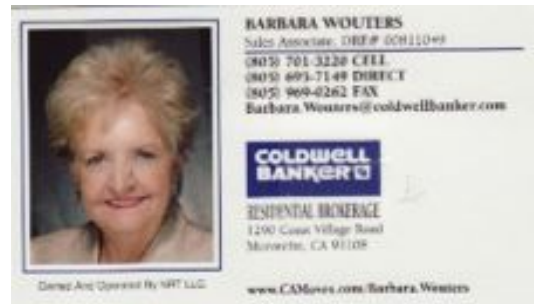

805-985-4300, after hours: 805-652-2405

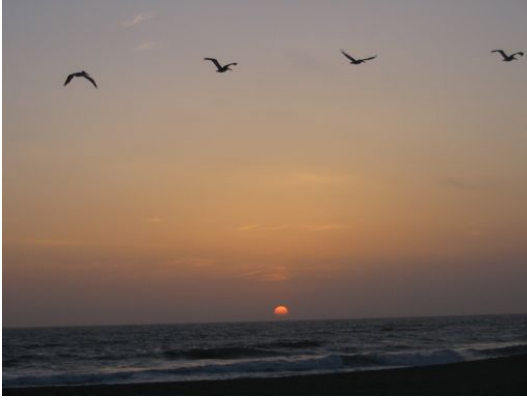
Emergencies include:
