

POOLS RULES

One of the usual signs of summer at HarborWalk are problems at the pools. We have already had an issue at pool 3 with a plastic bottle stuck in the skimmer port. This happened last year resulting in costly repairs to the pool equipment. Please cleanup after yourself when you leave and don't allow children in the pool area unattended.

Every summer the office gets complaints about glass and pets in the pool area. These are serious health violations. The office also gets complaints about too many guests and loud raucous activities. There are 244 units contending for 4 pools. No one unit should monopolize a pool or make it so other people are reluctant to go in. If you want to have a party, reserve the clubhouse.

- Hours 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM
- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- Children under 8 are not allowed in a spa
- Children 8-14 may not be in a spa without their parent
- No children in diapers in a pool or spa
- Beverages in unbreakable containers only, no glass and no food. Please clean up after yourself
- NO PETS in pool area
- Gates must be kept closed and locked. Someone in your party must have a pool key
- No more then four guests per unit, owners/tenants are responsible for the conduct of their guests
- No radios/mp3 players, etc
- Please follow the rules posted
- And of course, there is no lifeguard on duty, so please be careful

- * Leaking gas
- * Smoke or fire

*Anything that would put someone in danger

Locking yourself out of your unit is not an emergency. If the office is open, they might be able to help you if you have provided a key. After hours call a locksmith.
