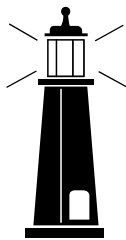

## POOL SECURITY

Just a reminder that the HarborWalk BOD has authorized additional pool security on July 4<sup>th</sup> as well as for the rest of the summer. If you have not registered your pool key with the HarborWalk Office, please do so immediately. Phone or e-mail is fine, just include key number and address. Security patrol officers will be patrolling the pools and comparing key numbers to address. This action has been taken to combat pool usage by people climbing the fence, tailgating, and neighborhood folks who have acquired a key.

## FLAGS AND BANNERS

Just a reminder that the HarborWalk CC&Rs forbid the mounting or flying of flags, signs and banners outside of your “exclusive use common area”. Flying a banner or flag within your unit, patio, or deck is great; just don’t damage the railings or walls. Anything that hangs outside of this area is a finable offense.



## EMERGENCIES

Does the HarborWalk office know how to contact you in case of an emergency?

Please provide the HarborWalk office emergency contact information and a key to your unit in case of an emergency.

If you have an emergency call 911. If it is something that HarborWalk can help with, contact the office during office hours at:

805-985-4300, after hours: 805-652-2405

Emergencies include:

\* Running water

\* Leaking gas

\* Smoke or fire

\* Anything that would put someone in danger

Locking yourself out of your unit is not an emergency. If the office is open, they might be able to help you if you have provided a key.

After hours call a locksmith.

## EMERGENCY SPA SHUTOFF

Most of the spas have a **RED** emergency off button. Please do not use this button to turn off the spa jets, except in an emergency. Using this button to turn off the jets under normal conditions causes harm to the motors costing Homeowners thousands of dollars in repairs each year.

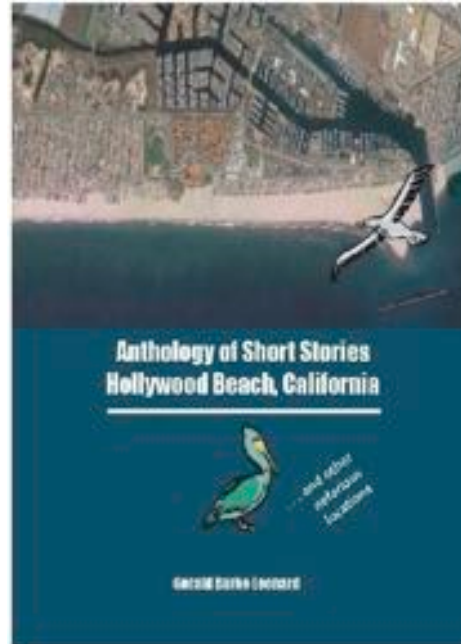
